But, like any good story, it has two sides. Take a trip back in time to an Oz before Dorothy, where a young and naïve Glinda meets a troubled but brilliant green-skinned Elphaba at Shiz University. Though they are yet to be good or wicked, the polar opposites of the bubbly, popular Glinda and the talented, lonely Elphaba eventually kindle a firm friendship, forged in fire.

With 22 magnificent songs, Wicked is an epic undertaking that will transport you to a land of magic and mystery, with a very human story at its heart.

Since its Broadway opening in 2003 the show has won 90 awards across the world, and you'll soon see why as this lavish story unfolds amid a whirlwind of song and colour.

The music of Wicked has become legendary in musical theatre, with the show's crown jewel, Defying Gravity, becoming a hit in its own right.

THINK YOU KNOW WICKED?

CHECK OUT SOME OF THESE FACTS BELOW!

- The Wicked Witch is not named in the original L. Frank Baum novel. Gregory Maguire invented the name for her using Baum's initial — L.F.B. — Elphaba.
- Think Wicked is dark? Gregory Maguire's novel is much darker. In his novel, Madame Morrible and Doctor Dillamond are both killed, but they receive a somewhat more merciful fate in the show.
- Elphaba's eminent emerald makeup is actual green eyeshadow rather than foundation! Check out this video of Idina Menzel getting 'greenified' [here!](#)
- For each show, the electronics department uses enough power to supply 12 homes and 250 pounds of dry ice are used to create the dramatic atmosphere on stage!
- Lyricist and composer Stephen Schwartz managed to squeeze in a small tribute to 'Over the Rainbow' in the song 'Unlimited/I'm Limited' in the form of the first seven notes (because eight notes can be considered theft of a song under copyright laws!).
- Up to 70 wigs are used during any given show. What's more, they're made of human hair and each one is made individually for each actor, using their own hairline in the front.
- Idina Menzel nearly blew her audition for Elphaba when her voice cracked on the last big note of 'Defying Gravity'. Of course, she went on to win a Tony Award for Best Actress in a Musical for the role. It's easy to see why when you check out this video of her belting out 'Defying Gravity'
